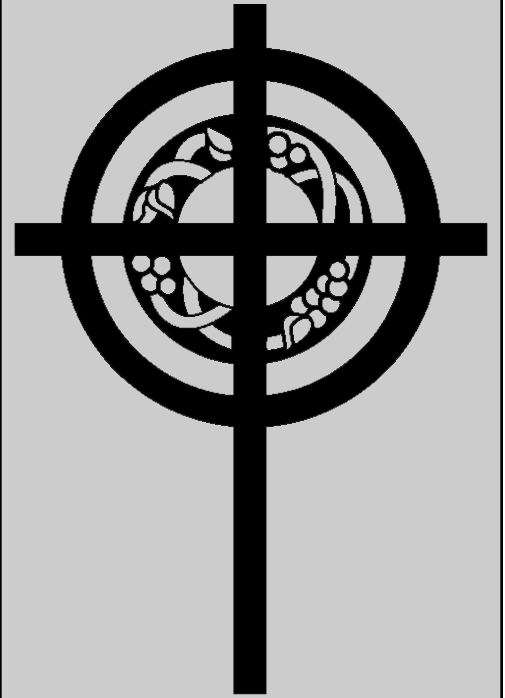
Come Celebrate God's Work!

PRESCHOOL



Scholarships

The State of Georgia allows you to direct a portion of your state income tax to support private school sponsorships.

Oglethorpe Presbyterian Preschool's Pre-K program is one of the eligible recipients. We have partnered with Georgia Student Scholarship Organization (GaSSO), a reputable organization handling funds for many private schools.

Here's how it works:

1. Register on the GaSSO website before December 31, 2015 (www.georgiasso.us).
2. Choose the amount you wish directed to Pre-school scholarship (up to \$1000 for an individual, \$2500 for a couple). Please note: this merely holds your place. It is not a *commitment* to give.
3. In January, 2016, the Department of Revenue will approve your registration and amount based on the total amount requested, subject to legal limits.

4. In February or March, 2016, you make your donation up to the amount approved by the Department of Revenue.
5. In the Fall, 2016, Pre-K families receive scholarships based on our criteria.
6. In 2017, you get a dollar-for-dollar reduction of your state income tax for your donation when you file your 2016 return.

In other words, your donation is not just a tax deduction, but a true tax credit. For example: if you donate \$1000 in 2016, your state tax bill will be reduced by \$1000 in 2017. It does not cost you anything, and it helps deserving Preschool families.

Now is the time to register! This program is limited statewide. If previous years are any indication, it will be over-subscribed by the end of the year.

Even if you are unsure about whether or not to give, please register now. Whether or not you donate, and how much you donate, are a decision you do not have to make until next year. Registering simply reserves you a place in line.

To register, go to www.georgiasso.us and click on the "donate" button on the lower left side.
