
### Report from the IPNC

The Session met on Sunday, June 19, and approved the following:

- Approved the minutes from the May 15 stated meeting and the called meetings on May 15 and May 22.
- Received the June Pastor's and Clerk's reports.
- Approved the following people to serve as counters: Ethan Gillespie, Jennifer and Matt Kim, Cathy Poley, and Jesse and Georgia Rappole.
- Approved renewal request from Our Lady of Assumption School to serve as their reunification center in case of emergency.
- Approved spending up to \$2000 on carpet where pews have

been removed.

- Approved fundraising for \$1,250, or 1/2, of our shared partnership with Emory Presbyterian for the New American Pathways Refugee Resettlement co-sponsorship.
- Approved increasing Cheryl Hartman's hours/salary to 40 hours/week.

*Session meetings are open meetings and are usually held the third Sunday of every month following worship.*

*Our open-book policy includes our finances and session minutes.*

## Transition Reminder

This is just a reminder that now that Marthame Sanders is no longer pastor here at Oglethorpe Presbyterian, there is a policy put in place by the Presbytery of Greater Atlanta to help with the transition of not only the church, but with Marthame and his family as they transition as well. The former pastor is not to be engaged in anything pastoral with his former church, including baptisms, weddings, funerals, and pastoral care. He must also not participate in any events in the life of the church, such as worship services, Sunday School, Bible study, social functions, fundraisers, etc. during the tenure of the interim pastor and for at least a year following the arrival of a new permanent pastor, following the departure of the interim.

However, this does not exclude the former pastor from remaining friends with former congregants, and attending such events as funerals for church members or weddings of church members. The most important thing to remember about this policy is that there are boundaries that need to be observed between the former pastor and his former congregation, and that the former pastor is no longer to be engaged in the same roles he once had in the church.
